She loves long walks as well as chasing cats and squirrels.



Advocating For a Healthier Choice

In an effort to give students in Sumner County the opportunity to make healthier choices in the school meals, three Gallatin High School sophomores addressed the Board of Nutrition about implementing vegetarian and vegan cafeteria options.

"We noticed that this school has a lot of vegetarians and vegans who don't eat during school because they don't have the options of eating their choice so we wanted to make it fair for everyone," said Niki Patel.

On January 31 Niki Patel, Kristen Moore, and Emily Ruiz offered the Sumner County Board of Education's Nutrition Board some menu options to consider.

"We asked them to add another option to the school cafeteria or replace one of the meat options and put one of the vegetarian options that" said Emily Ruiz.

We surveyed 200 students in enrichment and to see if they were or knew people who were vegetarian or vegan," said Kristen Moore. The survey indicated that a majority of students are or know vegetarian or vegans, "and it was about 50% who thought there should be vegan or

vegetarian options."

The girls incorporated this effort into an FCCLA competition called "Star Events" in the Advocacy classification. They won First Place in the regional competition on February 16 and will compete again at the state level on March 27-29.

The trio believes this topic is prize-worthy because not a lot of vegetarians are advocated for in the Tennessee school systems, but it is an issue that impacts a lot of people who will no longer need to bring food from home, particularly those students benefitting from free and reduced meals. Additionally, just having the vegetarian and vegan options on the lines will likely motivate non-vegetarian and nonvegan students to make healthier choices, the girls said.

"If we win it will help spread awareness to people and empower people to talk more about it to persons in power who can advance the cause even more," said Ruiz.
