The Gallatin Athletics Hall of Fame exists to recognize and honor Student-Athletes, Coaches, Teams, and Sports Contributors for their outstanding achievements and/or their outstanding contributions to the Athletic Programs at Gallatin High School and Union High School.

Nominees for the Hall of Fame may be nominated in any of the four designated categories of membership:

<u>Student-Athlete –</u>

- Inductees in this category accomplished superior individual achievement while representing Gallatin High School/Union High School as a member of the Green Wave/Red Devil Athletics program.
- Must have graduated Gallatin High School at least ten years prior to their nomination.
- Clearly exemplified characteristics of integrity and sportsmanship as a student-athlete, as well as citizenship before and after graduation.

<u>Coach/Administrator –</u>

- Inductees in this category are limited to those who served Gallatin High School/Union High School as a coach, administrator, and/or athletic director.
- Have retired from their respective program/role at Gallatin High School.
- Significant contributions made to the overall athletic program including longevity, overall record, and championships.
- Significant contributions made to the community or professional organizations for their respective sport or group.

<u>Team</u> –

- Inductees in this category are teams that had outstanding achievement while representing Gallatin High School/Union High School.
- Teams could include but is not limited to teams who earned a State Championship or State Runner Up in TSSAA competition.
- A ten-year waiting period from the time of the completion of the team's season will be imposed before a team is considered for induction in this category.

Sports Contributor –

- Inductees in this category are individuals or groups who have helped to develop and foster growth of athletics in the GHS athletic community.
- Any Gallatin High School student-athlete, coach, administrator, athletic director, community member, or group who had a significant impact on the athletic community may also be eligible for nomination.
