GHS first opened as *Trousdale-Allen School* in September, 1914. In 1915, the name changed to *Central High School* before moving in 1932 off of South Water Avenue. Calvin Short Field, dedicated in 2012 to the former Head Football Coach, still entices our students, staff and alumni on *Football Fridays* each year. We moved from this "annex" to our current location at 700 Dan P. Herron drive in 1974 with the "Freshman wing addition" completed in 1988.

The expansion was finished this year, allowing 23 teachers to have their own classrooms rather than to roam from class to class. This new building eliminated the portable classrooms that once were behind GHS. The new wing houses two new science labs with the latest technology to engage the millennial student body of over 1,400. In addition to the new wing, GHS now has a state-of-theart front office.
